

Community Residential Services (CRS) (Corporate Adult Foster Care) Accessible Space, Inc.



Accessible Space, Inc. (ASI) is a nonprofit organization incorporated in 1978 to provide affordable, accessible housing and twenty-four hour care services to low-income adults as an alternative to higher cost institutional care.

ASI's Community Residential Services (Corporate Adult Foster Care) homes are located in the Twin Cities metro area including Blaine, Coon Rapids, White Bear Lake, St. Anthony and Falcon Heights, Minnesota. Each house is an accessible, affordable home with private bedrooms for persons who have a brain injury or who have similar needs requiring a supportive living environment.

Residents work with an ASI Site Supervisor along with a county Case Manager to identify care needs and set personal goals. ASI provides a comprehensive package to provide support and guide residents towards increased independence in activities of daily living including physical cares, medication management, transfers, household cleaning tasks, problem solving, scheduling and tracking appointments, transportation arrangements and behavior management. Residents are invited to participate in ASI's activities and events, sometimes including vacations abroad!

Funding for the Community Residential Services (Corporate Adult Foster Care) is available to eligible individuals through Medicaid Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Waivers including the Brain Injury (BI) Waiver or the Community Access for Disability Inclusion (CADI) Waiver. Private payment arrangements may also be made with ASI.

The Community Residential Services (Corporate Adult Foster Care) are subsidized by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). Applicants must meet very-low income guidelines established by HUD to be eligible. Qualifying individuals pay only 30% of their adjusted gross monthly income for rent. Group Residential Housing (GRH) does not apply to ASI's Community Residential Services homes so residents usually have a larger portion of their income available for discretionary spending!
