Basic Admission Criteria

- Diagnosis of traumatic or acquired brain injury, or other neurological condition.
- Medically stable
- Pediatric for comprehensive day program
- Adults (21 years and older) for day and residential programs
- Voluntary involvement on the part of the potential client

Referral Process

NCEP's Admissions Coordinator works with case managers, families, physicians and individuals for a smooth transition process:

- Obtains all relevant information
- Schedules Pre-admission evaluations
- Completes Pre-admission report including recommendations

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
