Assisted Living Plus (24-Hour Customized Living)

ASI's mission is to provide accessible, affordable, independent and supportive living opportunities for persons with physical disabilities and brain injuries, as well as seniors. This mission is accomplished through the development and cost-effective operation of cooperatively managed housing, supportive living and rehabilitation services. ASI is now licensed as a Class F Home Care Provider and registered for Housing With Services through the Minnesota Department of Health. Assisted Living Plus is a service option available at select locations in Minnesota to help residents achieve their highest level of independence.

Assisted Living Plus

Assisted Living Plus service (24-Hour Customized Living) is available in St. Paul, Roseville, New Brighton, Mounds View, Brooklyn Park, Champlin, Minneapolis, Bloomington, Rochester, Grand Rapids, Duluth and St. Cloud, Minnesota in select home and apartment settings.

Residents with mobility impairments and/or brain injuries or similar cognitive disabilities have access to on-site Resident Assistant Staff 24 hours per day. Services are directed by the resident and may include service coordination, help with activities of daily living, housekeeping, meal preparation, behavior management and socialization. Residents with brain injuries or similar cognitive disabilities have access to additional on-site support.

Residents in Assisted Living Plus work toward increased independence with physical cares and other living skills. The service program is supervised by a nurse who works with the resident to develop an individualized plan of care. A Site Supervisor works directly with the resident to coordinate schedules and implement the care plan.

Eligibility and Funding

Applicant selection is based on the admission criteria, suitability for the services offered, and qualification for Assisted Living Plus service. Applicants must meet low-income guidelines established by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). Qualifying households pay only 30% of their countable monthly income for rent.



Minnesota Medicaid (Medical Assistance) funding for payment of the 24-Hour Customized Living Service is available through either County Human Service Agencies (Home and Community Based Waiver Services), or AXIS Healthcare. Arrangements may also be made with ASI to privately pay for Assisted Living Plus services.
